Dear Dr. Rice:


I am counsel for Sundus Shaker Saleh, an Iraqi woman currently living in Jordan. She has filed suit against members of the Bush Administration under the Alien Tort Statute alleging that members of the Bush Administration committed the crime of aggression, forbidden by Nuremberg, with respect to the Iraq War. She has named you as a defendant in this lawsuit.

I am also representing myself *pro se* in the Northern District of California. I am asking the Court to set new precedent that government officials have obligations under law to provide honest and candid information with respect to war and peace.

I have attached courtesy copies of the complaints with this letter.

The Federal Rules of Civil Procedure require that I take affirmative steps to serve the summons and complaints. I would appreciate if you would kindly forward this letter to your counsel so that I may discuss with her or him service of the complaints.
